

Weave a Simple Aumônière

Make an adorable small pouch using a simple cardboard loom. It's the perfect opportunity to use up left over yarn or hand spun samples too precious to be hidden in the bottom of a basket or thrown out.

This is a practical simple project that you can carry with you anywhere! You can use your finished pouch for coins, jewelry or treasures.

You will learn how to create your cardboard loom, weave your pouch and finish it with a button loop.

Materials: Participants will need scissors, a ruler, a pencil, a blunt yarn needle, small hair comb (optional), a large button (2 cm or 3/4 inch diameter) and a good assortment of fine to medium hand spun or commercial yarn.
